Troop 62's **BIG Trip** this year is Philadelphia/Baltimore. The trip cost is \$275 for boy scouts and \$315 for leaders/adults. In order to make all the necessary reservations and arrangements, we will need a count of scouts and leaders/parents that are going. Please let us know if you plan to go by making a \$50.00 deposit by February 22nd. The balance is due by March 22nd. Please note – *refunds will be 100% if a request is made by March 22nd. After March 22nd, refunds based on expenses not already incurred.*

Itinerary

Wednesday, April 11th – meet at Geissler's Supermarket parking lot (on Sullivan Ave) at **4:00 PM**. We are leaving at 4:30 PM sharp. We will be staying at a hotel near Philadelphia both Wednesday and Thursday night.

Thursday, April 12th – spending the day in Philadelphia - Independence Hall, Liberty Bell, and more.

Friday, April 13th – before heading to Baltimore, visiting other museums / places of interest (this will be based on survey results from Scouts)

Saturday, April 14th - spending the day in Baltimore; first stop will be Fort McHenry.

Sunday, April 15th – we will be leaving Baltimore after breakfast and stopping for lunch along the way and expected to arrive home around 5 PM depending on traffic.

Meals during the trip include Hotel / Troop provided breakfast, food courts for lunch, and the famous All You Can Eat establishments for dinner.
