Troop 62's **BIG Trip** this year is Niagara Falls and Western New York. The trip cost is \$275 for boy scouts and \$315 for leaders/adults. In order to make all the necessary reservations and arrangements, we will need a count of scouts and leaders/parents that are going. Please let us know if you plan to go by making a \$50.00 deposit by March 7th. The balance is due by March 28th. Please note – *refunds will be 100% if a request is made by March 28th. After March 28th, refunds based on expenses not already incurred.*

Itinerary

Wednesday, April 10th – Meet at Geissler's Supermarket parking lot (on Sullivan Ave) at **5:00 PM**. We are leaving at 5:30 PM sharp. We will be staying at a hotel near Utica Wednesday night.

Thursday, April 11th – Travel to Seneca Falls – Women's Rights National Park – continue journey and stay in hotel near Niagara Falls Thursday through Saturday night, featuring visit to Falls overlook at night

Friday, April 12th – Visit Niagara Falls and Park, Niagara Power Vista Museum

Saturday, April 13th – Spend the day touring Western New York, including Buffalo Science museum

Sunday, April 14th – Leave Western New York after breakfast, stopping for lunch along the way, and expected to arrive home around 4 PM depending on traffic.

Meals during the trip include Hotel / Troop provided breakfast, food courts for lunch, and the famous All You Can Eat establishments for dinner.
